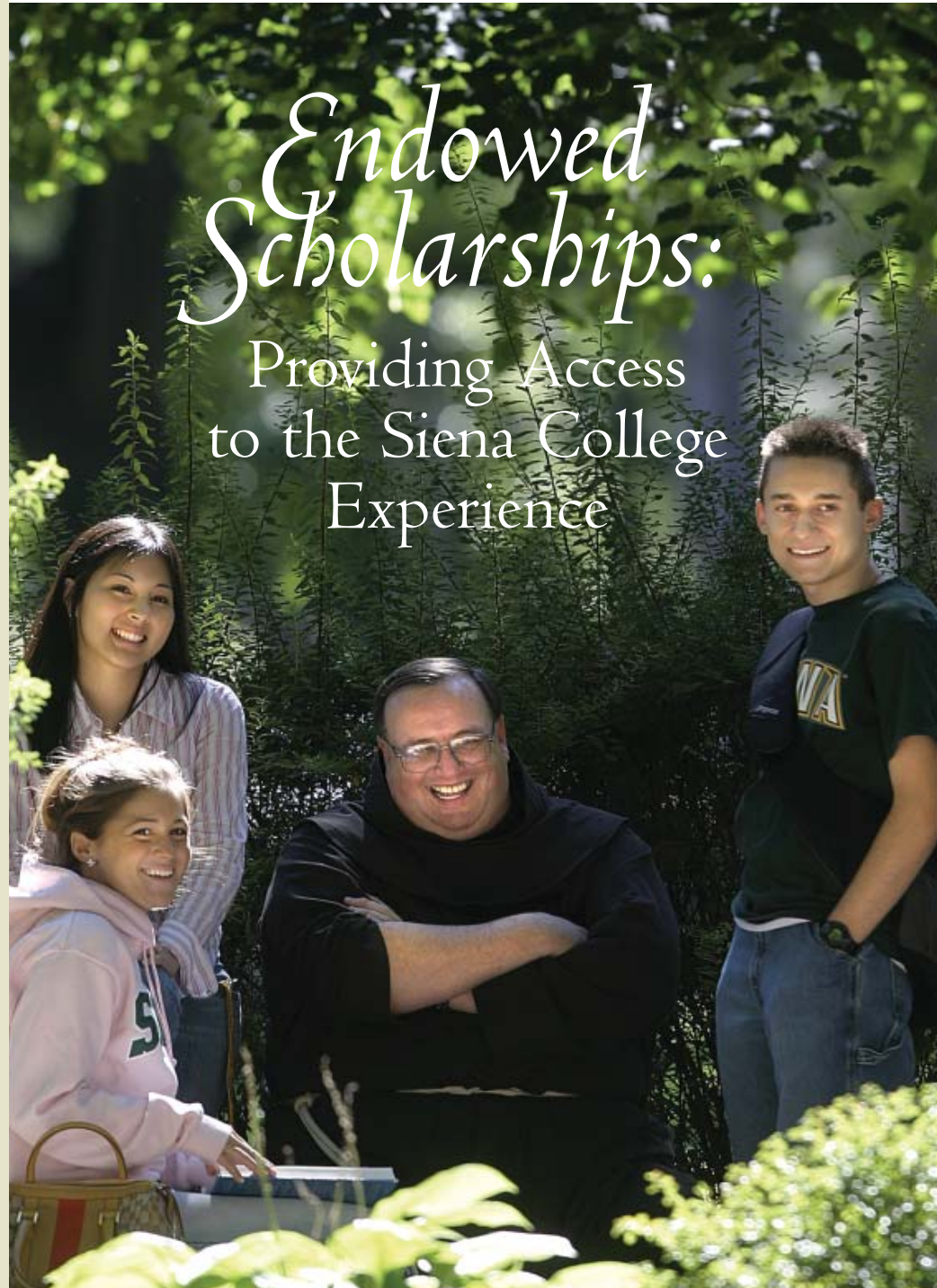

The Siena Experience

Siena College is a community of 2,900 undergraduate students advancing the ideals of a Franciscan and Catholic education. Siena students are educated to be competent, compassionate and community minded leaders. Since the College's founding by the Franciscan Friars in 1937, the College has made a commitment to educate young people of modest means. This commitment still guides the direction of Siena today.

Siena's focus is on undergraduate education; for our students this means:

- State of the art classrooms and laboratory facilities that prepare our graduates with knowledge and skills to excel in dynamic work environments.
- Learning experiences such as internships, study abroad, and research opportunities with faculty members that provide our graduates with the applied skills necessary for success.
- Small classes led by faculty members, 91% of whom hold the highest degree attainable in their field.
- An environment influenced by our Franciscan and Catholic tradition that prepares our graduates to be compassionate leaders in the communities they live and work in.



Making it Possible for All

Endowed scholarships support our commitment to making a Siena education within reach for those students who seek it. **85% of Siena students qualify for and receive some financial aid.** This level of support is made possible through the generosity of alumni, faculty, parents, businesses, and friends who endow scholarships at Siena College.

Facts About Endowed Scholarships at Siena

- Siena currently maintains more than 170 endowed scholarships.
- Scholarship endowments range in size from \$25,000 to more than \$2.4 million.
- On average, 600 students receive more than \$1 million in scholarship aid annually ranging from \$500 to full tuition.
- A gift of \$25,000 in a lump sum (cash or securities) or commitment paid over 1 to 5 years will endow a scholarship; scholarship aid is available in the year following the completion of the endowment.
- A gift of \$30,000 in a lump sum (cash or securities) or commitment paid over 1 to 5 years will endow a scholarship and provide scholarship aid immediately.
- A gift of \$500,000 in a lump sum (cash or securities) or a commitment paid over 1 to 5 years provides full tuition assistance for one student.
- Scholarships exist in perpetuity; investment income provides the annual award.
